

Our first GINGERBREAD HOUSE

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS



1 Make the gingerbread according to the recipe, roll it out and cut out the floor, walls and roof using the stencils.



2 Stick the walls to the floor using icing. You can find the ingredients and instructions for making the icing in the gingerbread house recipe.



3 Then place the roof on top. Insert half a toothpick at each gable end to make the house more stable. When the house is stable, you can start decorating.

ROOF

For the roof tiles, stick the flaked almonds to the lower edge of the roof and work upwards. For a more colourful alternative, you can use Smarties, mini marshmallows or gummy bears.



ICICLES

For the icicles around the roof, place a little icing in a piping bag and cut off a small tip. Place on the edge of the roof and then carefully pipe icing downwards applying a little pressure.
